## E-WASTE CATEGORIES

## EXAMPLES (but not limited to)

Office Equipment	desktop computers, laptops, tablets, printers, fax machines, copiers, scanners, adding machines, calculators, keyboards, printer cartridges, power strips, monitors, CRT screens, LED screens, docking stations, Wi-Fi set-ups, and battery chargers
Telecommunications	mobile phones, phone chargers, telephone systems, PBX systems, routers, pagers, LCD signage, and network hubs
Entertainment Equipment	analog televisions, LED televisions, DVD players, DVRs, iPods/MP3 players, MP3 chargers, stereo equipment, digital clocks, clock radios, speakers, plasma televisions, projector
Small Appliances	electric mixers, irons, coffee machines, blenders, waffle irons, toaster ovens, hot plate, slow cooker/crockpot, bread machine, microwave oven, rice cooker, electric kettles, and electric fry pan
Environment Appliances	electric heater, air purifier, air conditioner, humidifier
Lighting	light fixtures, lamps, and all bulbs
Personal Appliances	hair dryers, electric tooth brushes, lighted mirrors, curling irons, electric shavers, hair clippers, dental water picks
Medical Equipment	electric wheel chairs, bath lifts, and body massagers
Power Tools	electric drills, table saws, all electric hand tools, grinders, sanders, electric saws, and circular saws
Electric Fitness Equipment	treadmills, stair-steppers, elliptical trainers, exercise bikes, cardio equipment, electronic timing devices
Energy Equipment	electrical meters, monitors, wireless network hubs
